Rules of the Second Hand and Antique Photography Market

The Bièvres International Photo Fair is organised once a year by the Photo Club de Paris Val de Bièvres with the support of the town of Bièvres.

All exhibitors shall respect the following terms and conditions.

- I. No installation with a vehicle shall be allowed prior to the hour indicated on your pass. As per a convention between the organiser and the city of Bièvres, **sales are officially authorised only on Saturday from 1 to 7 pm and on Sunday from 8 am to 6 pm within the fair perimeter**. For reasons of safety and security, only the space allocated to the International Photo Fair may be occupied for the purpose of sales. Violators are subject to legal charges including expulsion.
- II. Before the installation of exhibitors, the organisers will supply tables and roof equipment to all those having rented a covered booth. Exhibitors may set up their booths or stalls beginning Saturday at the hour indicated on the exhibitor's pass **for sales beginning at 1 p.m.**
- III. **Exhibitors must undertake not to take down their booth or stall before the market's closing time of 7 p.m. on Saturday, 6 p.m. on Sunday.**
- IV. **Exhibitors must respect the spaces allocated to them.** The organisers shall not be held responsible for slight differences in measurements or for the possible presence of obstacles next to the stall, in spite of all efforts to avoid such situations.
- V. Exhibitors are responsible for their own stall or booth and belongings. Organisers shall not be held liable in case of theft or other incident.
- VI. For safety reasons, no vehicle movement shall be allowed within the Fair's perimeter during the hours at which it is open to the public. Only authorised vehicles may park within the fairgrounds ; all others must be left in the exhibitors' parking lot provided free of charge by the municipal authorities. Exhibitors renting only one linear metre and those booking on the spot (not by advance booking) may not access their site by car.
- VII. Only Fair organisers may use a sound amplification system.
- VIII. An acknowledgment of receipt of booking forms will be delivered to all exhibitors within 15 days of receipt of payment, followed by a booking confirmation in May, along with information regarding setting up the rented space and the booth number. Unauthorised "squatting" is forbidden. Any violators are liable to be expelled by the police. Exhibitors are expected to justify their registration by displaying their pass mentioning the booth number when requested by an official delegated by the organiser.
- IX. Any bookings cancelled less than a week before the Fair will not be refunded.
- X. **Exhibitors may offer for sale any old, used or substandard photography or cinematography product, as well as photographs and photography books. They may not offer any new material except in cases where manufacture has been discontinued for more than one year.**
- XI. **All exhibitors shall leave their rented space clean and in order after their departure.** Garbage bags will be provided to all traders during the weekend, and garbage must be discarded at designated spots on the fair grounds by 7 p.m. Sunday evening at the latest. Also on Sunday evening, booth material must be returned complete and in the same state as it was received. Any deterioration shall be charged to the exhibitor.
- XII. Any exhibitor expelled from the Fair for failure to respect these terms and conditions or the rules of public conduct shall not be eligible to reimbursement of any costs incurred. Having occupied a stall or a booth for several consecutive years does not guarantee similar rights in future.
- XIII. If, for reason of an unforeseen event (force majeure) beyond the control of the organisers, the Fair were to be cancelled, its organisers would not be responsible for reimbursement of registration fees.
